MICROSCALE EXPERIMENTS IN CHEMISTRY

A tug - of - war had also been going on in recent years, to balance the budget of running practical courses and the standards of experiments to be carried out by the students. Since the economy is always the winner, the number of experiments had been the losers. A group of scientists from University of Pune and Fergusson College, Pune are striving hard to maintain the standards of experiments at a friendly budget ie., by carrying out the organic reactions in capillaries / tiles, using semimicro test tubes for heating experiments(instead
