**Institute visit to NIFTEM – Thanjavur**

Venue: NIFTEM, Thanjavur

The Department of Chemistry has organized an Institute visit to the National Institute of Food Technology Entrepreneurship and Management, Thanjavur (NIFTEM-T). This is formerly, Indian Institute of Food Processing Technology (IIFPT). This academic institution is with Institute of National Importance (INI) status, functioning under the Ministry of Food Processing Industries (MOFPI), Government of India, Tamilnadu. This institute offers academic and research programmes in the field of food processing technology.

The students visited the food processing business incubation centre. The students were educated about various instruments like radio frequency driver, fluidized bed driver, spray driver and so on. The students also visited the chocolate producing line, Fruit juice producing line, Coconut based value added line, Ice-cream & bakery production line. They exhibited their products like Health mix, Diabetic puttu mix, Green wash (fruits & vegetables washer) and many more. This institute helps the farmers, self-help groups and entrepreneurs in manufacture & production of their value added food products. This exposure inspired the students to become entrepreneurs and start their independent small scale business. The students also got awareness about the internship and project opportunities provided by the institute.

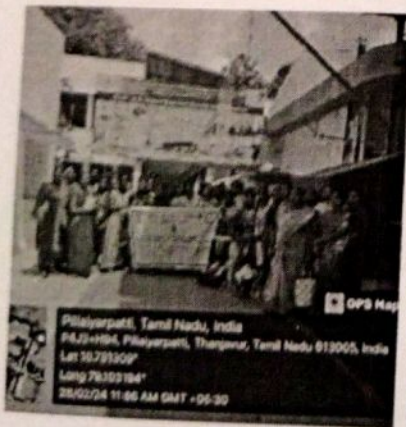
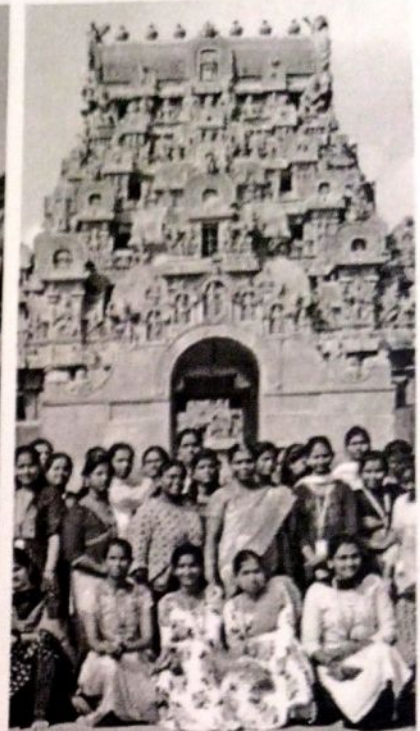
