The resource person inculcated the participants on the topic "Indexing & Citation". He explained referencing, citation and indexing. His session highlighted the importance of making reference from high impact factor journals and the benefits of publishing.

Technical Session V

The chief guest Dr.Sathya Parayitam Ph.D. Professor, Management and Marketing, Charlton College of Business, University of Massachusetts, Dartmouth, MA, USA addressed "How to write a Research Paper". He guided the participants about Do's and Don'ts to be kept in mind while preparing the research paper and gave a detailed explanation on the structure of the research paper. Professor displayed a research paper and review process and explained the expectations of a publisher.

Day: 3 (20.04.2022-Wednesday) Technical Session VI

The resource person of the third day of the International Faculty Development Programme was Dr.P.Srinivasan, Associate Professor, School of Management, Presidency University, Bangalore, Karnataka. He discussed "Introduction to Time series in econometrics" and focused on the types of data, Time series Analysis and its methodology with practical examples. He explained how to develop hypothesis testing using Excel. He also explained about simple linear regression models and multiple regression model building.

She shared her deep knowledge on methods of collection of primary data, how to prepare a questionnaire in manual and electronic form, types of questions, formatting of questionnaire, coding, master table preparation, diagrammatic and graphical representation, table preparation, statistical concepts and data definition. She has also shown real time models of covering letter, questionnaires, and master tables for better understanding. She also focused on the measurement and application of scaling techniques.
