**Report on One Day UGC Sponsored National Level Symposium on
“Economic Slowdown in India - Reflections and Remedies”**

The Department of Economics conducted UGC sponsored a one day National level symposium on “Economic slowdown in India-Reflections and Remedies”, dated on 05.03.2020 organised by Dr.R.Rajini, Associate Professor of Economics. The symposium was organized with the objective to know about the actual repercussion / outcomes of the economic slowdown such as the loss of growth momentum, production activity, employment opportunities, consumption, welfare loss etc, and find the remedies for the future of the economic growth.

Dr.M.Radha, Head, Department of Economics welcomed the gathering. Dr.V.Mohanasundaram, Associate Professor and Head Department of Economics, PSG College of Arts and Science, Coimbatore delivered the inaugural and keynote address. He emphasized the global, national and local scenario of the economic slowdown, causes and consequences of economic slowdown. In his concluding remarks, he spoke upon the barriers to the economic growth and the remedial measures.

Dr. Suneetha Esampalli, Assistant Professor and Head, Department of Economics, St.Anns College for women, Hyderabad was the resource person and shared the first session on “Economic Development in India- Its Casualties”. She visualized the Indian economic conditions and explained the measures to recover the economy from the slowdown. She also gave an elaborative explanation on the impact of economic slowdown in various sectors of the economy and its revival.

Dr.S.Janakiraman, Assistant Professor of Economics, Government Arts College, Coimbatore, has shared the second technical session. He discussed on the topic “Deglobalisation, Emergence of population and economic slowdown”. He stressed on deglobalisation and demonetization and its impact on population. He also explained about green growth rate and clean growth rate. He shared about the drivers of economic growth such as consumption, investment, the contribution credit, supply chain management etc. He suggests deregulation, the

contribution of NBFI, IBC and insolvency and bank policies etc. He also discussed about India's economic slowdown due to the rapidly spreading corona virus (Covid-19) pandemic. The impact of technical sessions and other deliberations on the participants was ineradicable.

The Valedictory session was addressed by Dr.Sugantha Ramamoorthi, Head i/c, Department of Economics, Lady Doak College, Madurai. She compare the current scenario of financial slow down with China, Singapore, Dubai, Japan etc. she motivated the students to have start ups and measures to improve the micro small and medium enterprises in India. She also discussed about the revival of cyclical fluctuations through innovative and value added products.

We hope that the fruit of this symposium will reach all the participants and academicians in the field of higher education and will work positively for the vibrant functioning of the economy and accreditation at large.

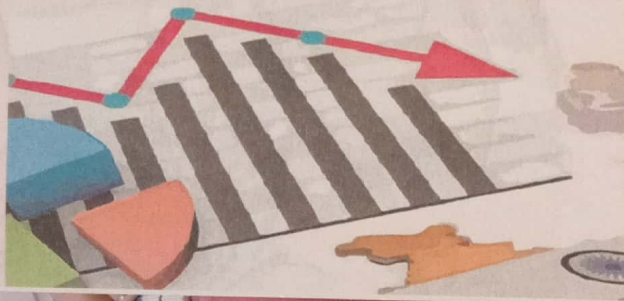

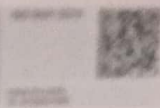
