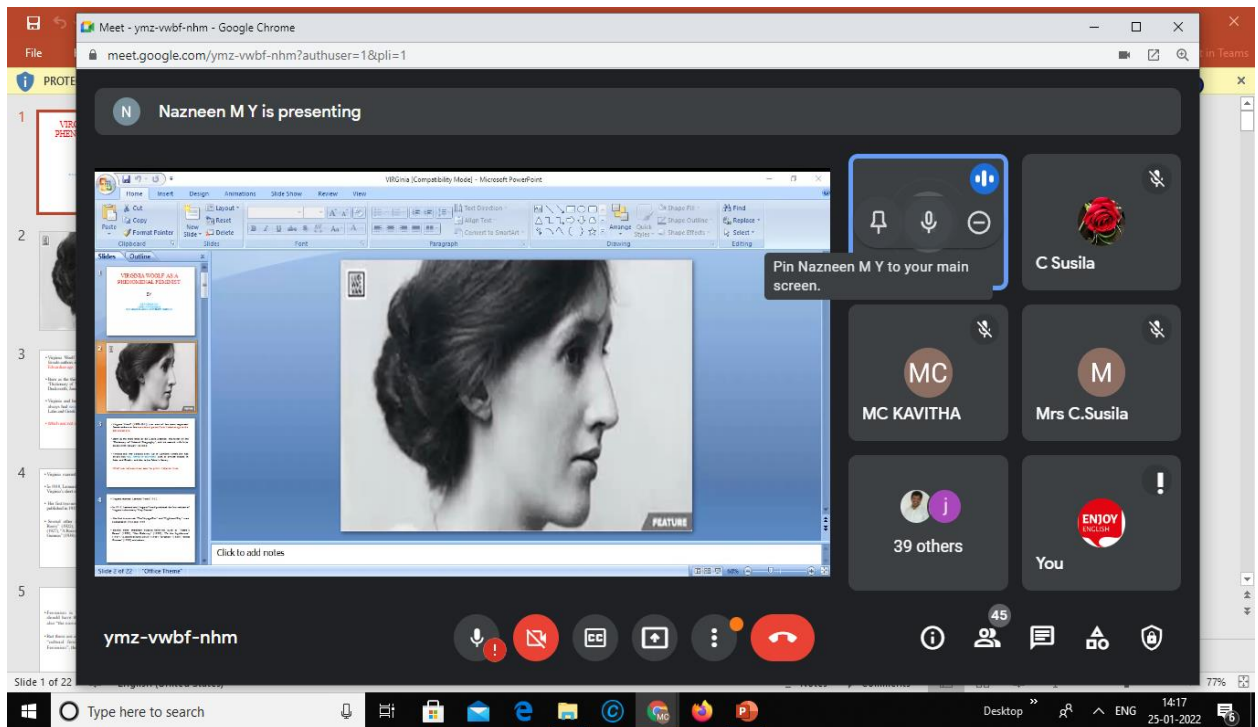
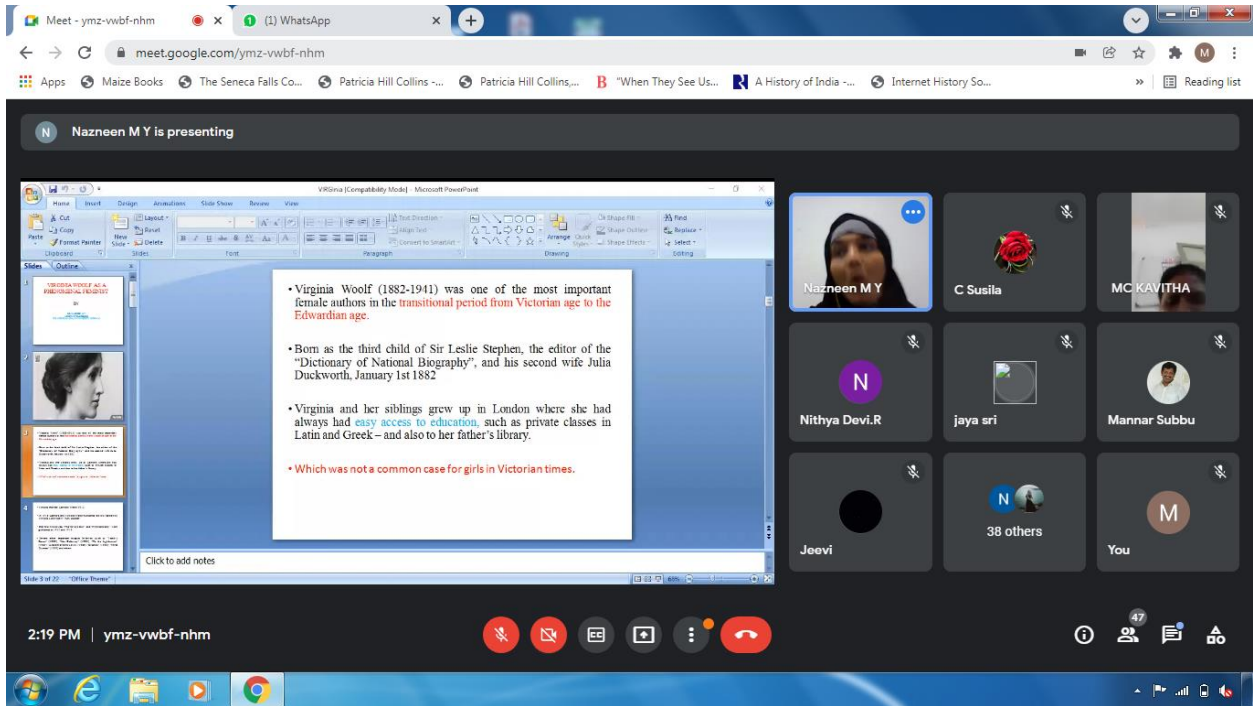
The Webinar on “**Virginia Woolf as a Phenomenal Feminist: Celebrating Virginia Woolf on her 140th Birthday**” was organized by Department of English on her birthday on 25th, January 2022 through video conferencing using Google Meet. The Webinar was organized with the aim to celebrate Virginia Woolf and her works, one of the prominent writers of 20th century. The aim was to create interest in the minds of the young students about Virginia Woolf and motivate them to read her works and use her theories in research. Dr.M.Y.Nazneen, Assistant Professor of English, B.S. Abdur Rahman Crescent Institute of Science and Technology, Chennai, has acted as the Resource Person. A total number of 65 students including research scholars and faculty members were benefitted.

The Webinar started at 2 p.m. with the welcome address by Dr.C.Susila, Assistant Professor of English. She also introduced the Resource Person.

Dr.M.Y.Nazneen clearly explained the life and works of Virginia Woolf and her importance in English Literature. 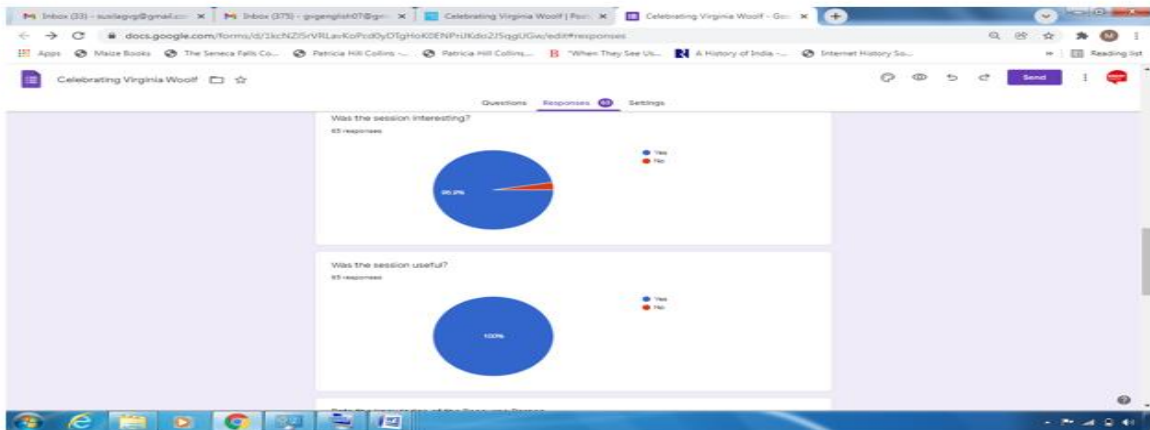
