REPORT ON INDUSTRIAL VISIT

The Department of Mathematics(Aided) arranged an industrial visit on 10.01.2020 and 11.01.2020. Totally 43 Students from III B.Sc Mathematics and II M.Sc Mathematics accompanied by three staff members visited CSIR Fourth Paradigm(Mathematical Modeling and Computer Simulation) Institute and TIFR(Tata Institute of Fundamental Research) For Applicable Mathematics at Bangalore.

The students were initially taken to CSIR Center for Mathematical Modelling and Computer Simulation (C-MMACS). They were able to know new areas of Computational Geology and Computational Biology.
