Mr. G. Kannabiran, Co-ordinator of science festival 2022, appealed the students to take science to the society.

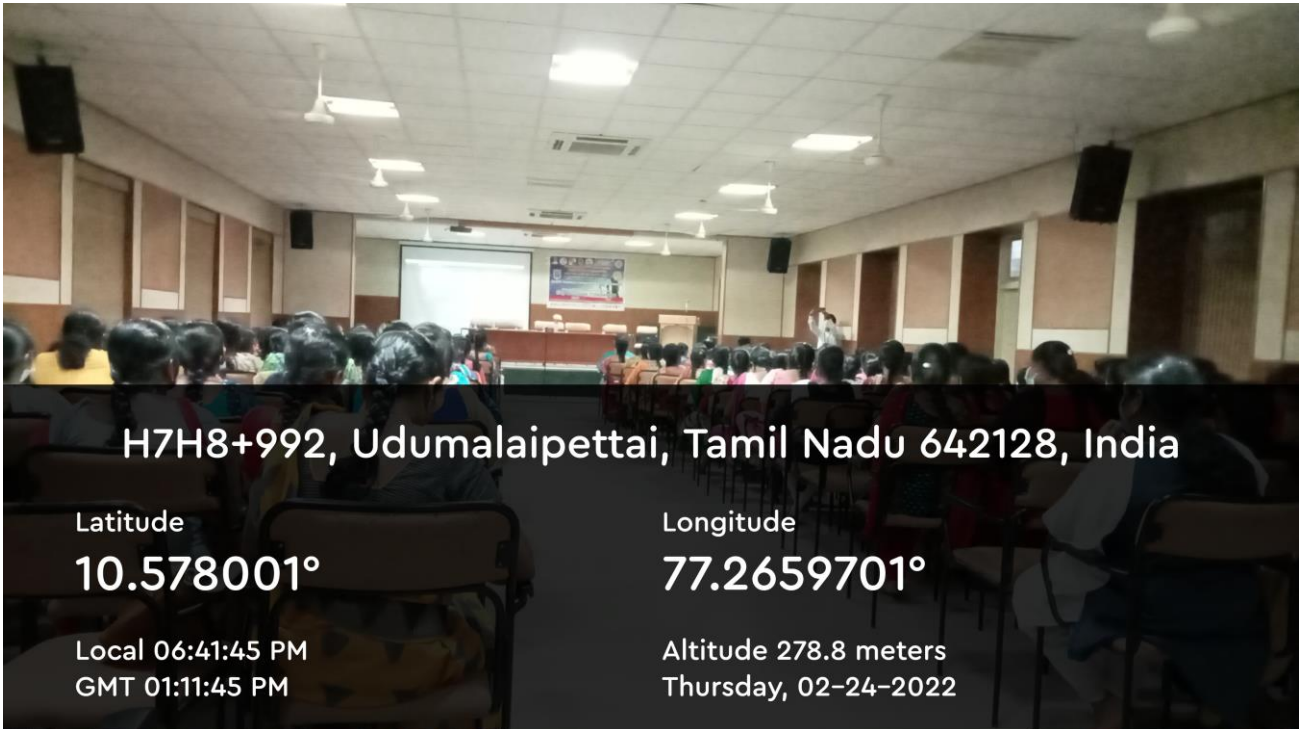
