Introduction

Polystyrene, commonly known as Styrofoam, is what most plastic pens are made from - they take 500 years to decompose, at a minimum. If we burn them, they cause air pollution. If we dispose of them (or lose them), they cause land/soil pollution. Paper pens will be a great alternative for these hazardous plastic pens.

Awareness programmes to avoid the use of 'SINGLE USE PLASTICS' has been identified as one of themes for the Iconic Week celebrations of the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEFCC), Government of India under Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav.

Hence the Green initiatives and environment club is encouraging students to use paper pens or fountain pens and the club is also conducting a training programme on "Making paper pens" to the students and awareness was given to avoid plastics.

Objectives of the Programme

- To make the students a "Green Consumers" and Green Entrepreneurs
- To empower students to innovate and implement eco-friendly strategies.
- Exhibit student's ideas for reducing plastic wastes and reusing paper wastes
- To ensure the environmental knowledge translating into environmental behaviours and to make the campus Plastic Free.

The environmental club commenced its activities with workshop on "paper pen making - A great alternative to plastic Ball pens"; On 8/9/2021 (II year) & 9/9/2021 (I year) students. The workshop started with the brief introduction by Devadarshini, III BSc Zoology. The Videos of making pen were shown and the students were given with refills & paper, gum. They were asked to make paper pens.

The hazardous effects of plastic to the earth and the time taken to degrade was explained. Students participated actively and were trained to make different types of paper pens. The importance of being green consumers was also explained. They were motivated to avoid plastics wherever it is possible. 112 students have attended. Few refills were given to them for making and the pens were collected from them.

Overall the Programme gave awareness on avoiding single use type plastics. The change in attitude and behaviour in avoiding plastic is the expected outcome of the Workshop. Moreover this pen making will help the students to earn money while they learn.

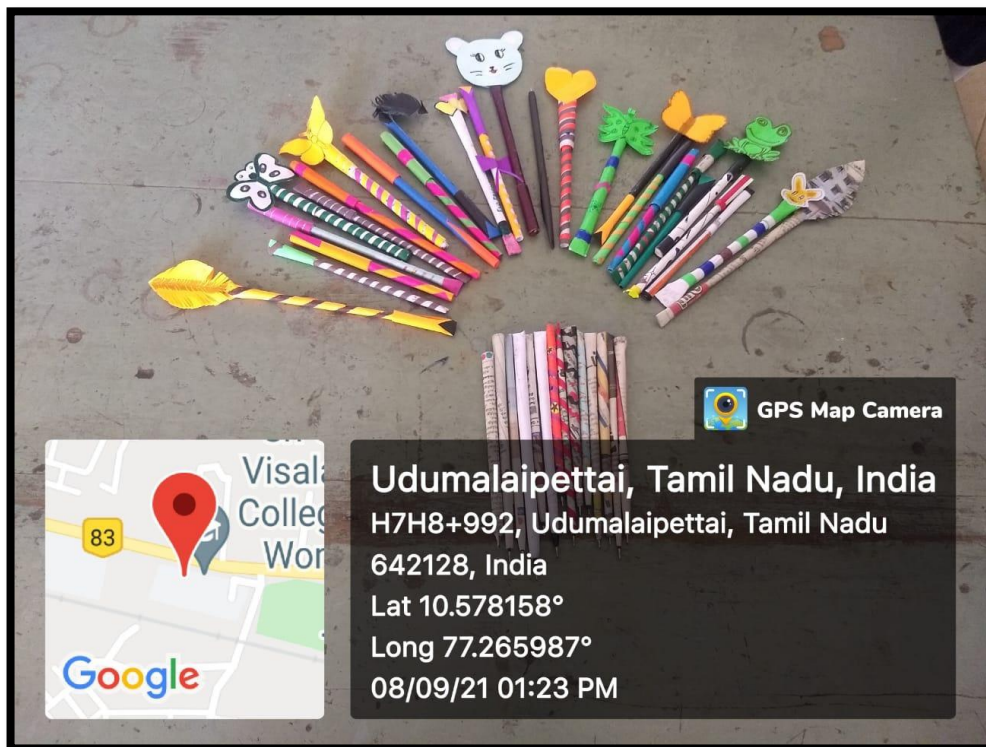

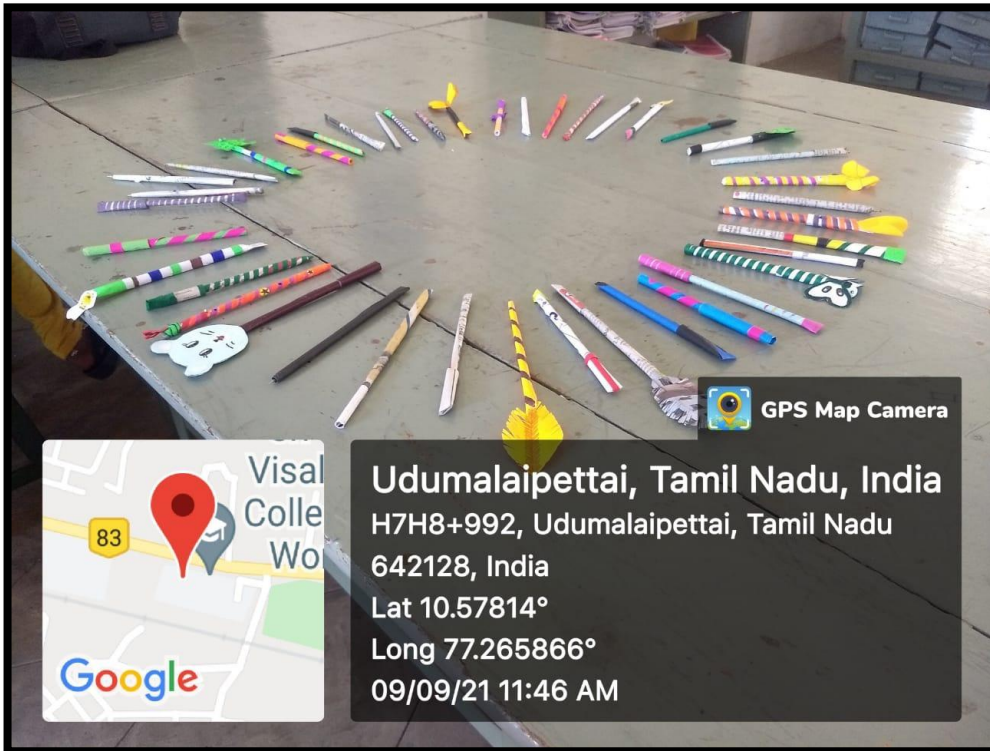

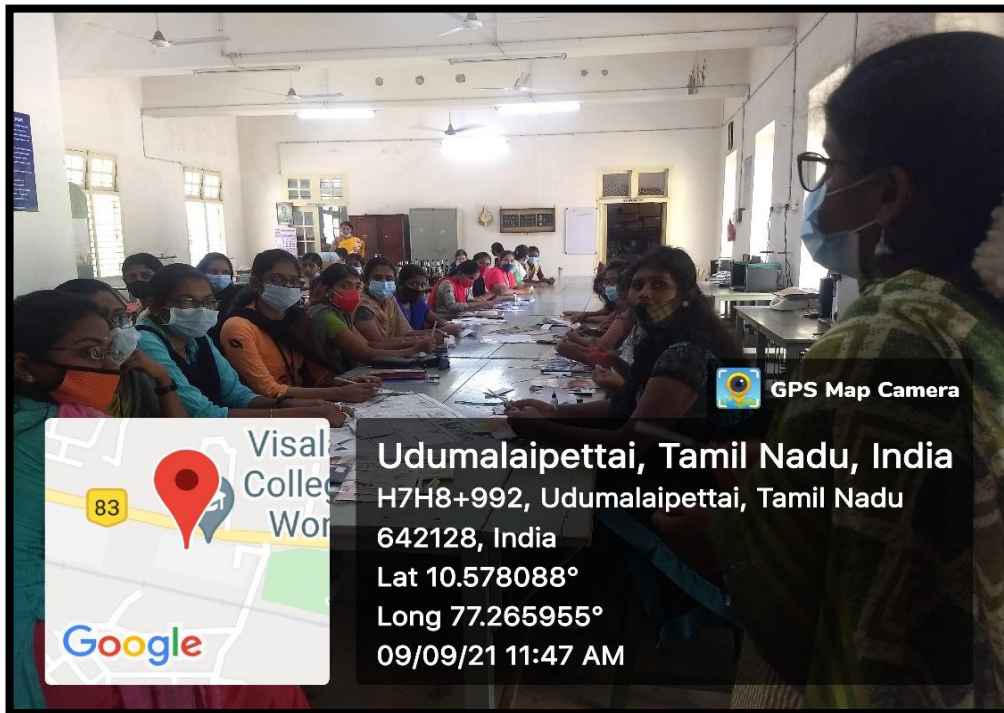


Miss. HARshini, Student of II B.Sc. Zoology trains the students



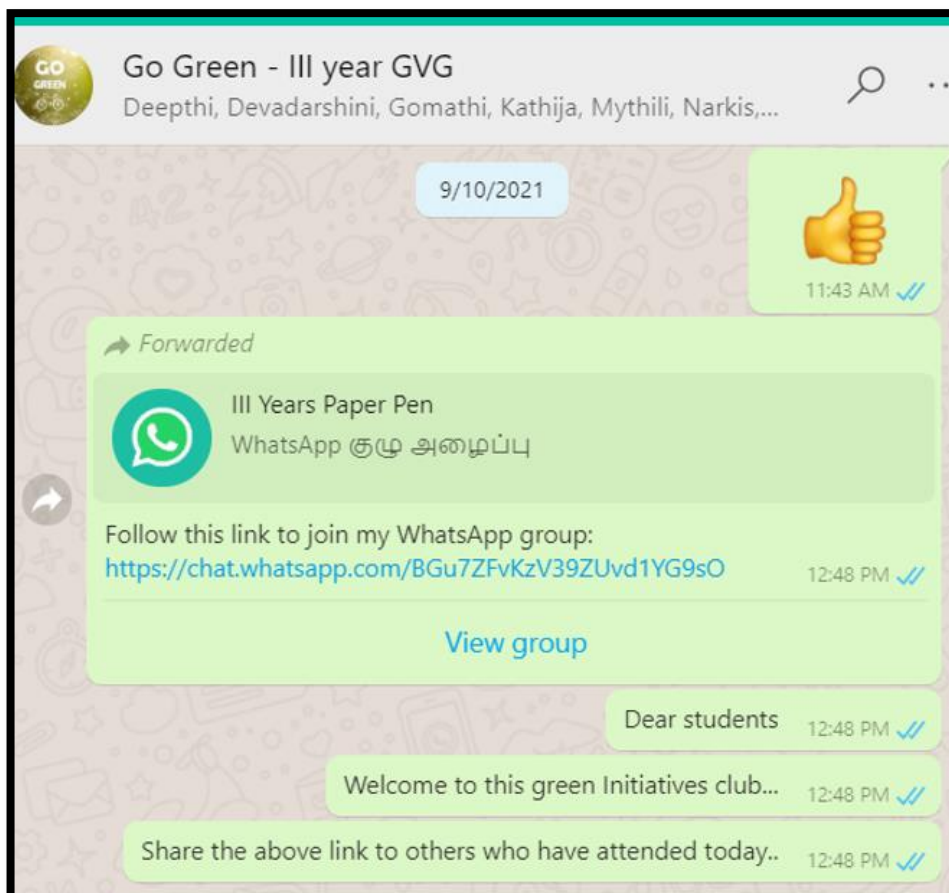


Miss. Devadarshini, III B.Sc. Zoology Explaining the harardous effects of Plastics and the amount of plastics thrown by a student daily
