Food adulteration is the act of intentionally degrading the quality of food offered for sale either by the admixture or substitution of low-grade substances or by the removal of some valuable ingredient. Adulteration affects the quality of the product leading hindrance to the nutritive value of the product thus leading to nutritive deficiency in our body and some of the food adulterants are highly toxic for the body leading to cardiac arrest, liver and kidney



disorder & many more. Consumption of adulterated food items and food colorants lead to many diseases, particularly "Cancer" a major problem that society faces now-a-days. The above information were explained by our students.



A group of 29 students and three teachers Dr. M. Malarvizhi, Mrs. V. Anitha, Dr. E. Vaishnavi were participated in the extension activity with enthusiasm.
