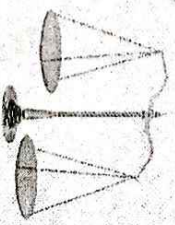

LEGAL AWARENESS PROGRAMME REPORT

Legal Awareness programme was conducted with magnanimous support of National Commission for Women, New Delhi. Recognizing the need to in part legal awareness to women and girls regarding the rights the commission is initiated a countrywide legal programme for women exclusively.

The effectiveness of this programme was felt in the deliveries of resources persons & discussions on various aspects of law, modes of disputes settlement mechanisms in family court, cyber law and rights to property.

The programme was started with lighting of the lamp by the dignitaries. The lamp lighting gave wisdom to make this occasion with blessings and all humility.

Dr.M.Mehar Banu Assistant Professor of Economics Women Studies Center member invited the gathering with the introduction of the chief speakers in a grand manner. Next our revered madam Principal Mrs.K.Kalaiselvi in her presidential address delivered that women are gifted to be born as women, women must cultivate her habits to gain knowledge on various facts of law. Girls in their adolescent age must be aware of the legal law. So that they will not be caught in the clutches of dangerous hazards in the society. Women education should be trust on enforcement of law.

Inaugural Address

In our Inaugural address Dr.K.Durgalakshmi, Principal Government Law College, Salem. Highlight the significant of law and she expertises in the field. She covered the wide spectrum of situations which arise among the family due to the rights and responsibilities.

Dr.L.Dhanalakshmi proposes to the vote of thanks to the inaugural functions.

Technical Session I

In Technical Session the topic first began by Mrs.Shasthiri Srinivasan in her delivery clarified procedures and norms for guardianship and adoption maintenance. Her clarification in adoption was noteworthy. She authenticated that the law has several courts through which only the problems faced by men and women in division of property in the families can be done. It is only the law which could help them to overcome the problems and suggestions for the adoption of children by the parents. She emphasized what? where? when? and how? The guardianship of the child should be legally done.

Technical Session II

Dr.K.Durgalakshmi Principal Government Law College, Salem, in her speech stress why family law is important? Her indepth knowledge in the field of family law discrimination focused the discrepancies which are harmful to the society.

She coated several reasons for divorce. Cruelty as a ground for divorce, Adultery Law in India, child custody. She reinstated the laws Sec.26 of Hindu Marriage Act 1955 and Sec.38 of the SPM Act 1954 started that divorce by mutual concern in India was possible. Additional grounds for divorce for wife voidable marriages are being available in the Indian court of law. Finally, she concluded for any kind familial problems that arise in the society Supreme Court provides the opportunities to solve through court of judgement.

Technical Session III

Mrs.M.Vennila Advocate, Coimbatore District Court with advancement of technology she brought many views which are a serious threat to the society. She said every individual should be concerns about oneself in using the electronic gadgets. She emphasized that each individual should not be erratic simultaneously the girls individually should not be immoral and glamorous.

She concluded that womenfolk should have self esteem to keep them in the prestigious in the society. Women's behavior, self-control and not getting attractive towards immoral activities.

The law renders the helping hand to those women who leave their life without losing morality. Moreover a girl child has every right to claim right to the property as equally to the boy children in the family.

Technical Session IV Moot Court

In Technical Session IV Mock trial & Moot Court demonstration was performed by young budding lawyers, Coimbatore. In their play, demonstration was based on how a born Hindu by with engaged with Muslim family born girl. The dispute between the two was discussed. The court of law & judges dealt the case. In that case, the Muslim boy himself purpose converted him as Hindu for getting admission in Medical College. But he has demanded his wife the born Muslim girl not to attend social functions in Hindu Community. She was restricted to attend Hindus custom. Though they lead a life after their marriage since 7 years. The dispute between the two becomes stronger. Ends the case was discussed as per the judgement the Muslim girl submitted her permission. In final judgement divorce will not be given and they should lead a life with mutual consent.

The above advocates and judges come out with the following views.

In our country a wide number of people are freely practiced. The major religions practiced in dude Hinduism, Islam and Christianity. People solemnize marriages in accordance with religious rituals and ceremonies, which are mostly codified by statutory personal laws.

The matrimonial laws in India, including laws on marriage, divorce and other connected issues are essentially, governed by the personal laws of the parties depending on their religion. Special Marriage Act 1954 applies to all religions. This is as civil legislation and parties from all religions caste or community can elect to marry under it. A divorce would then be governed by the Special Marriage Act 1954. The family court been matters relating to marriage marital breakdown and the welfare of children. These courts are trial courts and are presided over additional district judges which undertake trials and review evidence. The family courts follow the civil procedure code.

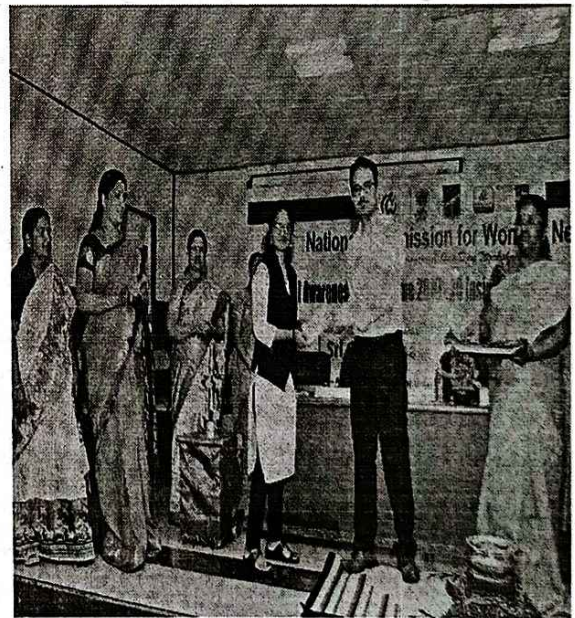
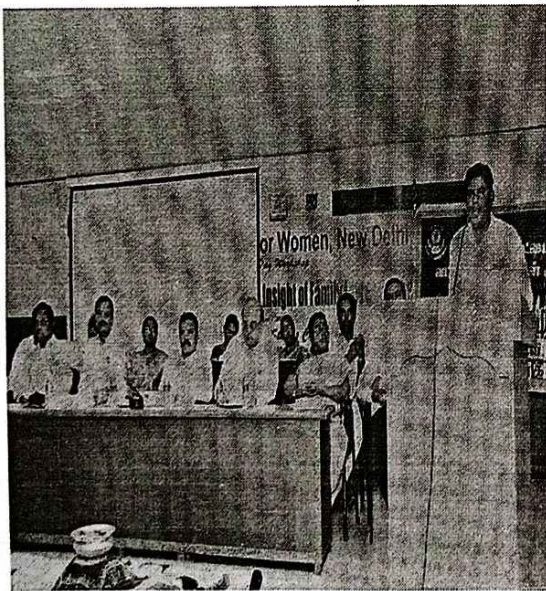
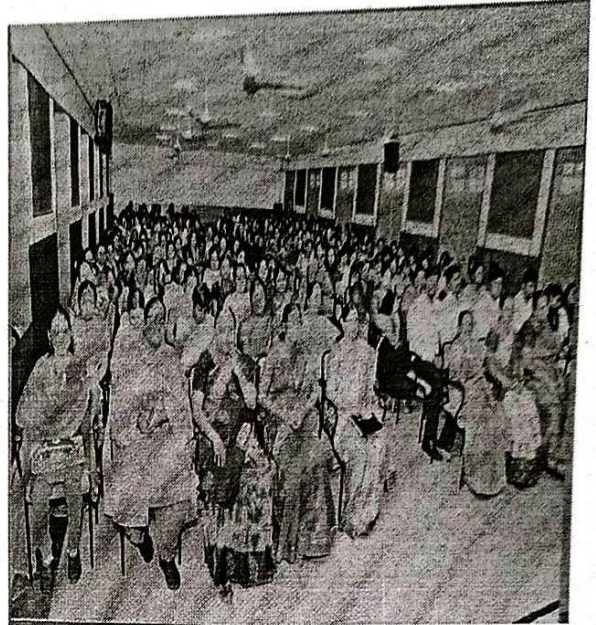
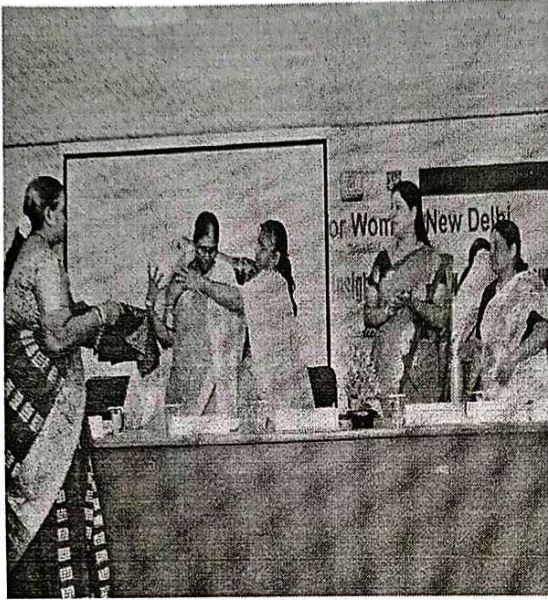
Valedictory Function
