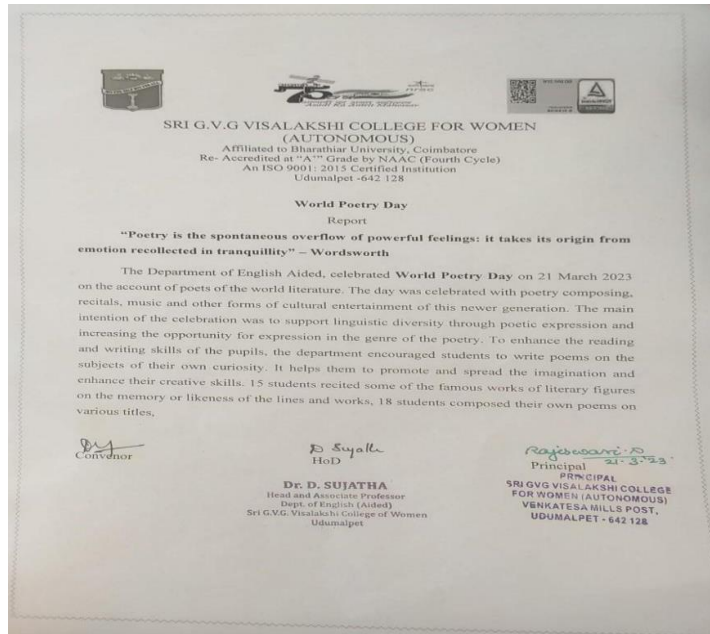


Then, the Proficiency Prizes, Shields and certificates were awarded to the best performers in Academics, Games, NCC, Office bearers and other activities.

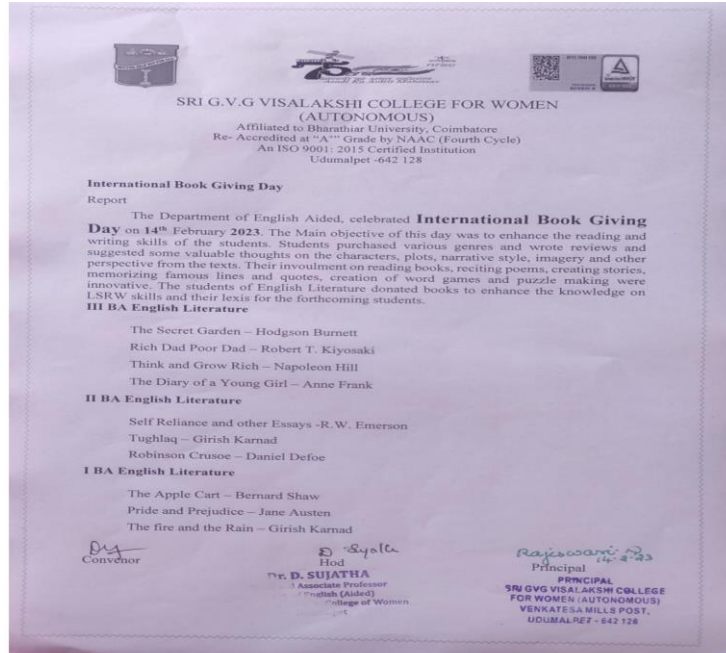

The celebrations continued after Assembly in the Conference Hall I.


