The peer team members scrutinized the following documents:



- Minutes of the Statutory Bodies – Governing Body, Finance Committee, Academic Council and Board of Studies

1.	Governance, Leadership and Management	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ The minutes of mandatory committees verified and it is as per the rules of UGC ➤ The funds received from the UGC and other bodies have been appropriately utilized and the UCs submitted in time and approved
2.	Admission	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ The admission process is transparent and abides the rules and regulations of the State Government
3.	Curricular Aspects	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ The curriculum has been revamped, enriched and updated as per the need of the hour. ➤ Action taken reports are maintained in a proper manner. ➤ Under outcome based education attainment of course outcome is calculated. ➤ The feedbacks of alumni, employers, stakeholders and industrial personnel and the analysis is properly taken into consideration while revamping the curriculum. ➤ CBCS is offered for Allied, Elective courses, Non-major elective and advanced learners courses. ➤ MOOC's courses are introduced in PG curriculum. ➤ Course exist survey is conducted for each course at the end of the semester and program exist survey at the end of the final semester in online mode. ➤ While framing the curriculum the course exist survey done by the students are considered.
4.	Teaching & Learning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Apart from chalk and talk method innovative methods like Participatory Learning , Internships, case studies are also included.

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Online classes have been conducted after March 17th through various learning platforms to complete and revise the syllabus. ➤ Guidelines are prepared to conduct online classes and examinations.
5.	Evaluation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Second internal assessment test has been conducted through online from 15th June due to the pandemic situation. ➤ The evaluations of examination papers were also done through online mode.
6.	Research & Extension	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ The departments - English, Commerce and Economics have produced five PhD's. ➤ Five faculty members have been conferred with the doctoral degree in this academic year. ➤ Extension activities like awareness on various government programmes, food adulteration, road safety, post office schemes, Fit India etc. have been carried out. ➤ Seed ball preparation was done in collaboration with Aaranya Charities.

Student Support & Progression	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Under the guidance of students council advisor student council functions vibrantly. ➤ Under various clubs variety of activities has been conducted. ➤ Effective mentoring is carried out during the pandemic situation. ➤ To promote mental and physical health Yoga and GVGVC helpline were introduced for both faculty and students. ➤ Some of the commendable achievements are:
