Governance, Leadership and Management 2. Admission	 The institution has a proper documentation of the activities of the Statutory Bodies. The admission process is transparent and abides by the rules and regulations stipulated by the

The Board of studies meeting is conducted each year with the participation of academic experts, industry experts and the alumni. Action taken reports are in place. Outcome Based Education has been implemented from June 2017. The feedback for the curriculum is conducted online and the analysis is presented to the Board of Management. CBCS is offered for the Elective Courses, Non-Major Electives and the Advanced Learners Course Exit Survey is conducted Online at the end of every semester.

Teaching & Learning	 The traditional chalk and talk method is supplemented by innovative teaching methods like: Gallery Walk, Glogster Presentation, Webinars, Teleconferencing, Internships, etc. Learning Management System – CAMU has been effectively utilized by the faculty and the students enabling "Anytime, anywhere learning".
5. Evaluation	 Result Analysis is carried out for every semester and the same has been discussed in the Council Meeting. More security features have been added to the Grade Sheet. Internal Assessment Marks are made available to the students in the Students Portal of LMS.

6.	Research and Extension	 Research Cell has prepared an action plan to enhance the research activities and submission of research proposals. Extension activities, especially towards the access to livelihoods of Persons with Disabilities are commendable.
7.	Student Support and Progression	 Student Council functions vibrantly in a democratic manner under the guidance of Student Council Advisor. Spectrum of Activities has been conducted under various clubs. Alumni Association has contributed in various spheres of functioning of the institution. Mentoring is carried out in an effective manner. Value-Added courses that meet the need of the hour are offered every year. Some of the Commendable achievements are K. Shifaisha of II BA English Literature received an International Award at Dubai for her Oratorical Skills. D. Aarthy of II B.Sc Mathematics (SF) participated in II International Speed Skating Championship, Nagpur, won Three Gold Medals and bagged Individual Championship. Three other students participated in State and National level Tournaments.
