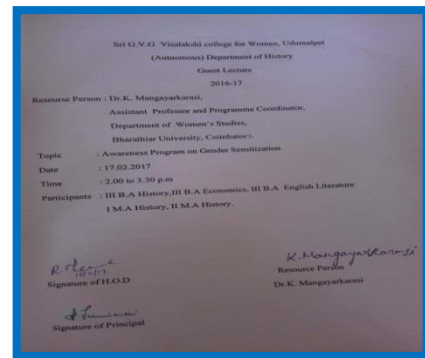

- The Grant is subject to the adjustment on basis of Utilization Certificate in the prescribed Proforma submitted by the College.
- The College shall maintain proper accounts of the expenditure out of the grants, which shall be utilized, only on approved items of expenditure.
- The Utilization Certificate to the effect that the Grant has been utilized for the purpose for which it has been sanctioned shall be furnished to the University Grants Commission as early as possible.

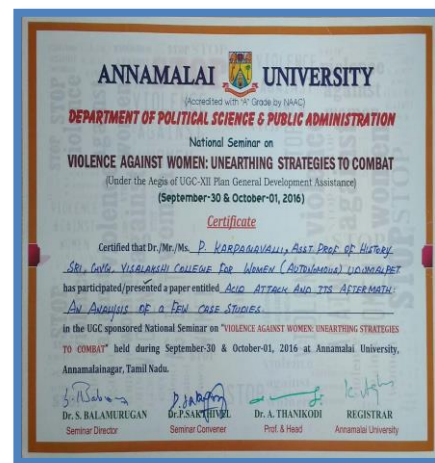
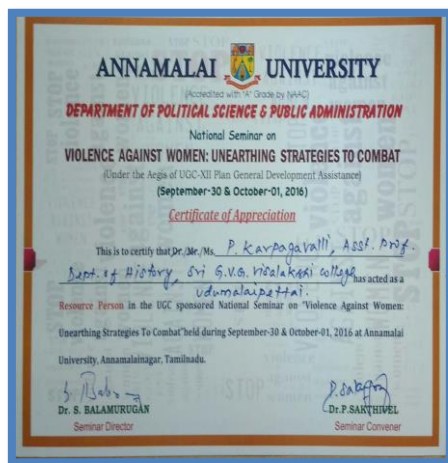
