A study was made regarding the parental involvement in their children's education with a special reference to Sri GVG Visalakshi College for Women, Udumalpet. The study mainly focused on the women headed families and how a single parent manages her children's education. 2431 samples were collected from 27. 03.2018 to 01.04.2014 through online feedback method. Among 2431 students 206 are having their mother as their head of the family. Mainly
