#### Scope:


This policy applies to all the people in the college campus.

### **Purpose:**


The policy provides the guidelines to the students, faculty and other in the campus regarding conservation and protection of the environment .

#### **Procedure / Practices:**

- Minimal use of water consumption.
- Turn off the computers when not in use.
- Turn off all the electrical equipments before leaving the class room/labs/campus.
- Students residing in the neighborhood of the college can reach by walk or use bicycles.
- Vehicles are entertained in the campus with driving license, insurance etc
- Students and Staffs are advised to park their vehicles in the parking space provided.
- Trees are pruned, watered and appropriate care is taken for the maintenance.




## **Plastic free campus**
