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




Hands-on-Training on Student Centric Teaching Methods **Organized under UGC Paramarsh Scheme** Date: 11th & 12th February 2021

The second day of the training was exclusively on training the faculty on e-content preparation. With a brief introduction to e-content, the Resource person trained the faculty on animated e-content, screen captured e-content development and OPENSHOT video editor.

Edmodo tool for online evaluation was also explained. All the sessions were lively and the participants actively participated.
