Two of our Paramarsh mentee colleges Shree Abiraami College of Arts and Science for Women, Gudiyattam and Rev.Jacob Memorial Christian College, Ambilikkai were awarded accreditation by NAAC.

It is time to profusely thank the munificent management for the unstinted aid to the sports students and for spending a huge amount of Rs.26,33,400/- to patron and accelerate the sportsmanship of the distinctive national and state level players by waiving off their semester fees, paying remuneration to the coaches, providing stipend to the distinct players, offering free boarding and lodging, and completely taking care of the travel allowances of the players to participate in various matches across the nation. I am very much delighted to share that, 34 of our sports students were benefitted out of this gesture. Our management spend around Rs. 1,60,000 towards band instruments, uniform for 30 students, coach fee, conveyance expenses and activity expenses on & off campus.
