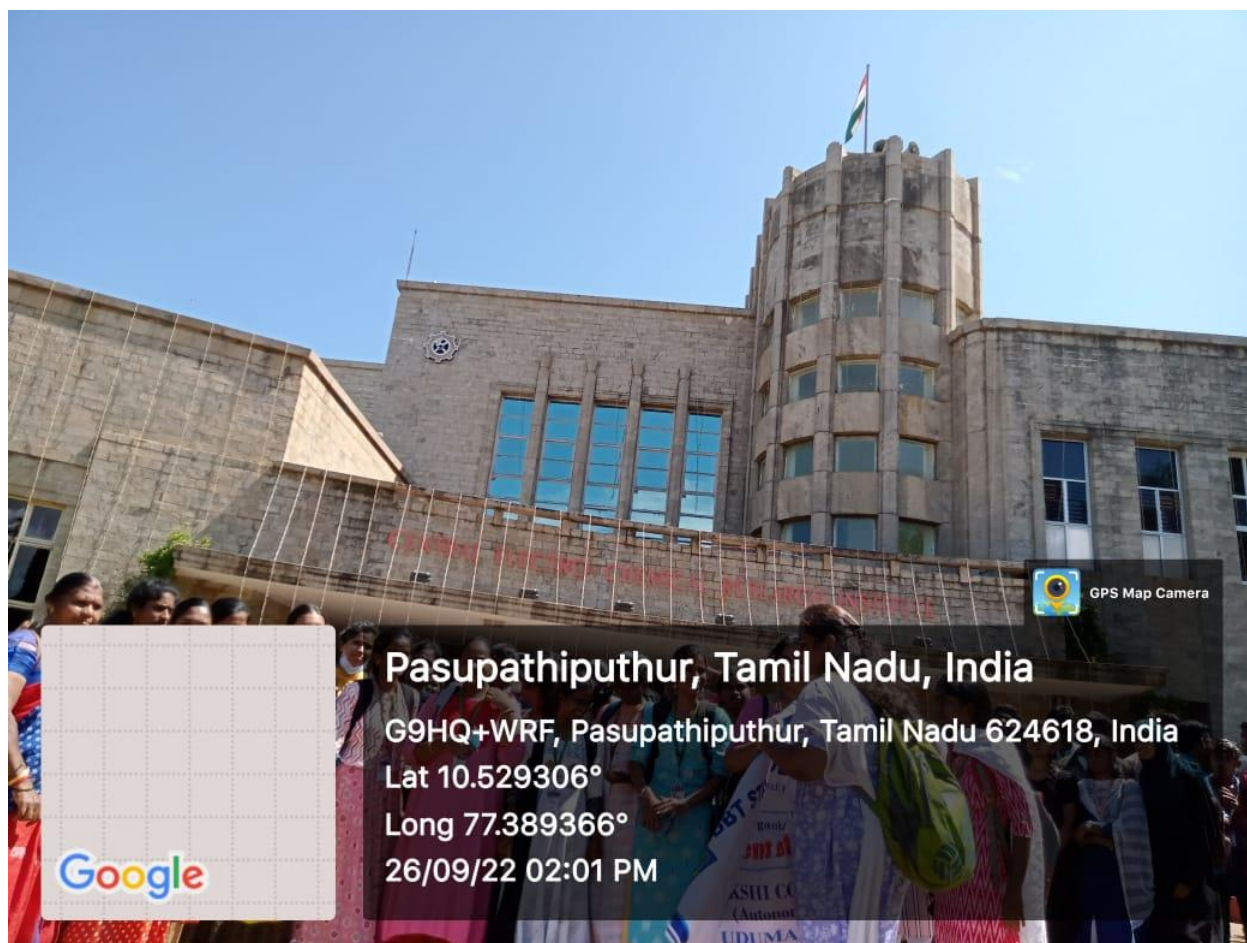




A group of 70 students and 2 Faculty visited the Central Electro Chemical Research Institute (CECRI), Karaikudi on 26.9.22 (open day).

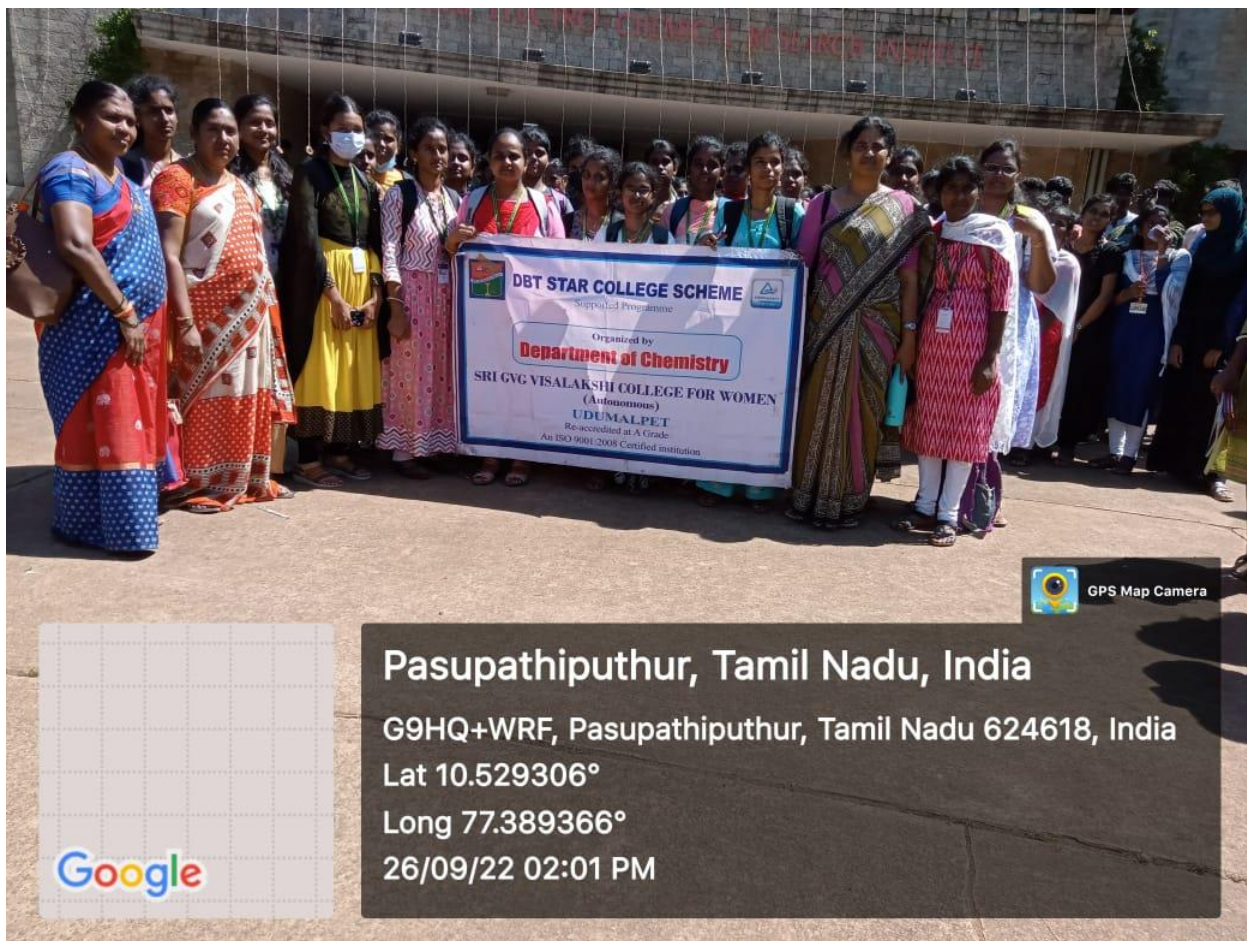
