No. of Beneficiaries : 37 students + 3 Faculty

A group of 14 students of I B.Sc. Chemistry, 24 students from II B.Sc Chemisty and 3 faculty members visited the Udumalpet Municipality solid waste dumpsite near the town municipality market. Students understood that The Municipality is responsible for setting up, operationalization and coordination of the waste management system and for performing the associated functions, namely:

- Ensuring segregation, collection, storage, transportation, processing and disposal of waste
- Ensuring channelization of recyclable plastic waste fraction to recyclers
- Creating awareness among all stakeholders about their responsibilities
- Processing of municipal solid wastes
- Municipal authorities adopt a combination of technologies to make use of wastes so as to minimize burden on landfill. Following procedures are adopted, namely
- The biodegradable wastes are processed by composting, for stabilization of wastes.
- Mixed waste containing recoverable resources is considered for the recycling process.
- Incineration is also used for processing wastes in specific cases.

 Land filling is restricted to non-biodegradable waste and other waste that are not suitable either for recycling or for biological processing.
