The following were the suggestions and recommendations made by the Board and the resolution approved.

Semester II

A new course Core X British Drama with the code 19MV10 was introduced in Semester III instead of British Literature III.

A new course Core XII Cultural Studies with the code 19MV12 was introduced in Semester III instead of Translation Studies & Practices.

A new course Core XIV Literary Criticism I with the code 19MV14 was introduced in Semester III instead of Theatrical Arts.

Semester IV

A new course Core XV British Novel with the code 19MV15 was introduced in Semester IV instead of British Literature IV.

Elective IV Personality Enhancement for Careers with the code 19MVE7 was introduced in semester IV instead of English for Competitive Examinations.

Elective IV Principles of Academic Writing with the code 19MVE8 was introduced in semester IV instead of Advertising for Media since it was shifted to semester II.

The board suggested that articles from reputed journals may also be prescribed in the syllabus.

Resolution :

Resolved that the curricular framework and design of the course contents be approved for the courses of the Semester III and IV for M.A. English Literature for the students admitted from the academic year 2019-2020 onwards in the PG Programme.
