

(vi) Scholarship for Children of Defence Personnel

Those students who are the Daughters of Defence Service Personnel can apply for Full Fee Concession. Application Forms for Scholarships will be distributed to them soon after the applications are called for by the Director.

(vii) Scholarships to the Children and Grand Children of Freedom Fighters

Those students who are Daughters or Grand Daughters of Freedom Fighters can apply for Full Fee Concession and forms of application for scholarships will be distributed to them soon after the receipt of Director's orders calling for applications.

(viii) Scholarships to the Children of Ex-Servicemen

Daughters of Ex-Servicemen studying in the College are requested to contact the D.S.S.A. Board Office for the supply of application form and other details.

(ix) Harijan Welfare Loan Scholarships

Those scheduled caste students who are staying in recognised hostels can apply for the award of Harijan Welfare Loan Scholarship. They are requested to contact the Director of Harijan and Tribal Welfare, Chennai – 600 005, for the necessary form of application.

(x) Kamaraj Endowment Scholarship is awarded to students who have brilliant academic record.

Fee Concessions for the Students

Full Fee concession under E.V.R. Nagammai Memorial Women's Free Education upto degree level will be granted to all students admitted from 1989-90 onwards (irrespective of the community to which they belong) provided the annual income of the parent / guardian does not exceed ₹ 24,000/-.

Scholarships

The following Scholarships are available to the students.

(i) Government of India Scholarship

Students belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes are eligible for the award of the scholarship.

(ii) Backward Class Welfare State Scholarship

Students belonging to Backward / Most Backward Classes can apply for the award of the scholarship if the annual income of their parents does not exceed ₹ 50,000/-.

(iii) National Loan Scholarship

Those students who have secured 50% and above in the aggregate in Higher Secondary Examination or equivalent can apply for the award of National Loan Scholarship. First preference will be given only to those who have secured 60% and above.

(iv) Harijan Welfare Scholarship under State Scheme

Those Students who belong to A.D. converts are eligible to apply for the Harijan Welfare State Scholarship. The annual income of their parents should not exceed ₹ 1,00,000/-

(v) Scholarship to the Physically Handicapped Students

Prescribed form of application can be had from the Director of Social Welfare, 485, Anna Salai, Nandanam, Chennai-600 035 on requisition with self-addressed envelope. The Director will publish the notification in *The Hindu* every year.

When teachers are on leave, their classes are engaged through the play of Audio-Video Cassettes.

Seminars are conducted using Slide Projector and L.C.D Projector to supplement the chalk and talk method.

English Language Laboratory

A New Language Lab is established with 30 systems, 30 ear phones and a server. Skillmate Software Version 3.1 sp is installed to improve the communicative ability of the students. The LSRW skills of the students are strengthened by the Audio-video courses. The facility to record the voice of the students enable the teacher to assess the performance of the students. Resume Writing, GD, Interview and Corporate Courses prepare the students for placement.

NSS / Physical Education / NCC / YRC / RRC

Each first year student should undergo training in any one of the following NSS / Physical Education / NCC / YRC / RRC till the end of fourth semester. The training classes will be conducted outside the class hours. Indoor Stadium is made available for the promotion of indoor games.

The Indoor stadium has a seating capacity of 1000 spectators and it has three Badminton Courts, One Volley Ball Court with wooden flooring and has provision for three Table Tennis Courts. It facilitates the table tennis players to use the ball feeder Robo. The speciality of the stadium is that each and every part of the exterior decoration is reusable and has the eligibility to go under green audit screening. This can facilitate game day experience the frontiers of our players to National and International arena.

Rules and Regulations of the Institution

a) General Discipline

The students are expected to maintain a high standard of discipline and uphold the reputation of the institution. They should refrain from involving themselves in party politics and anti-social activities. Violation of this will be strongly dealt with.

- ⇒ The students are personally responsible for the college properties like furniture, electric fittings, lab equipments etc. In case of any damage, penalty will be levied.
- ⇒ The students are expected to keep the surroundings clean. They should not scribble on the walls or throw litter in the class rooms.
- ⇒ Only licence holders are permitted to come to the college by two wheelers. Cycles and two wheelers must be parked only in the respective parking stands.
- ⇒ The students must wear their ID cards daily to the college and they must produce the cards on demand.
- ⇒ There is no ragging in the campus. The Anti-ragging Vigilance Squad will keep a watch over the attitude and behaviour of the senior students towards the juniors and vice versa. The relationship between the seniors and juniors must be warm, friendly and cordial.

b) Attendance

- ⇒ Each student should earn 85% attendance to appear for the End Semester Examination.
- ⇒ Leave letter should be submitted by the students before taking leave. Dayscholars should get their leave letters signed

by their parents or guardians and hostel students by their warden.

- ⇒ In case a student suffers from illness for more than three days, she should produce a medical certificate.
- ⇒ Dayscholars should get the permission of their respective Heads of the Departments for leaving the campus in the afternoon.

Dress Code

The students are expected to dress modestly and wear clothes that reflect Indian culture. Except jeans and banians, they may wear all formal dresses. They will be provided with a uniform saree which must be worn on Independence Day, Republic Day, College Union Inauguration and other specified occasions.

Hostel

The students must maintain discipline in the hostel. They should be civil to one another in the hostel and obey the rules of the hostel. All problems should be sorted out through proper channel. Wastage of food and water is strictly prohibited. Hostel students should take care of their belongings.

They will be sent home periodically and holidays will be given for important local and national festivals. They must return to college promptly on the appointed day, failing which fine will be levied. They should not extend their stay at home unofficially and without permission. There is a Home Theatre for watching movies and other recreational facilities like Indoor games are available.

- 📖 The books must be returned promptly on the due date, or a fine of ₹ 1 per day will be collected.
- 📖 Reference books are not meant for circulation.
- 📖 Transaction of books is also carried out through computers.
- 📖 Sub-lending library books is not permitted.
- 📖 Reprographic facility is available.
