


#### **BIO – DATA OF THE RESOURCE PERSON**

# REPORT ONLINE WORKSHOP HELD ON 29.05.2021

Department of English SF conducted an online workshop on Enhancement of Communicative Competencies on 29.05.2021 by providing a link on Google Meet. The resource person Mr.S.Dakshinamurty enriched the students by providing more insights on the importance of LSRW skills.
