**Clause 1 – Cooperation**

- 2.2. **Curriculum Design:** Second Party will give valuable inputs to the First Party in teaching, training and curriculum design to reduce the gap between industry and academics.
- 2.3. **Industrial Training & Visits:** Industry and Institution interaction will give an insight into practical exposure, latest developments / requirements of the industries; the Second Party to permit the Faculty and Students of the First Party to visit its premises and also involve in Industrial Training Programs for the First Party. The industrial training and exposure provided to students and faculty through this association will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to working career. The Second Party will provide its Labs / Workshops / Industrial Sites for the hands-on training of the learners enrolled with the First Party.
- 2.4. **Research and Development:** Both Parties have agreed to carry out the joint research activities in the fields of Textiles and Apparel and related fields.

- 2.6. **Guest Lectures:** Second Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lectures to the students of the First Party on the technology trends and in - house requirements.
- 2.7. **Faculty Development Programs:** Second Party to train the Faculties of First Party for imparting training as per the industrial requirement considering the National Occupational Standards in concerned sector, if available.
- 2.8. AIC-NIFT TEA act as a Knowledge Transfer Centre (KTC) and interface between Educational Institutions and Industry. As a KTC AIC-NIFT TEA will facilitate the transfer of knowledge, ideas of students/faculty, so that they will be used in practical commercial applications.
- 2.9. Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programmes on the terms specified herein.

Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MoU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

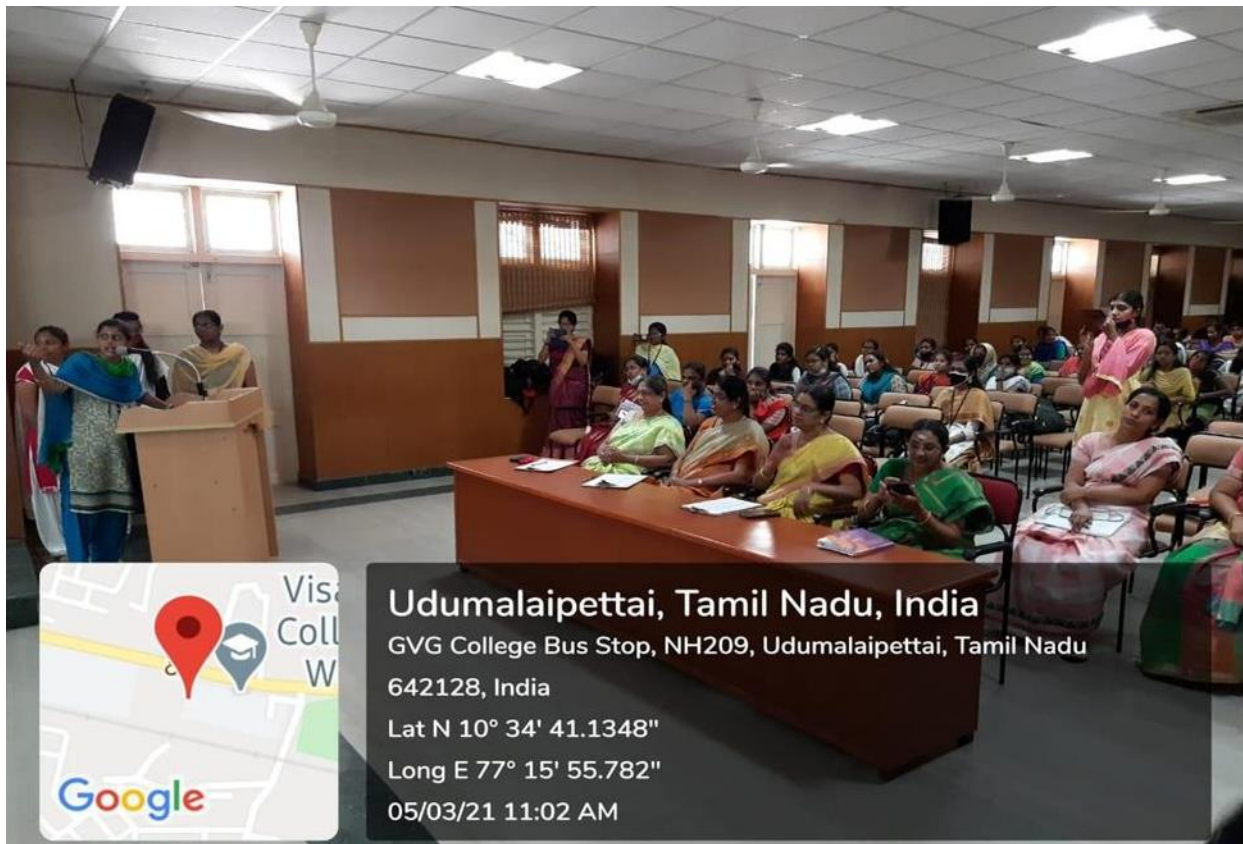

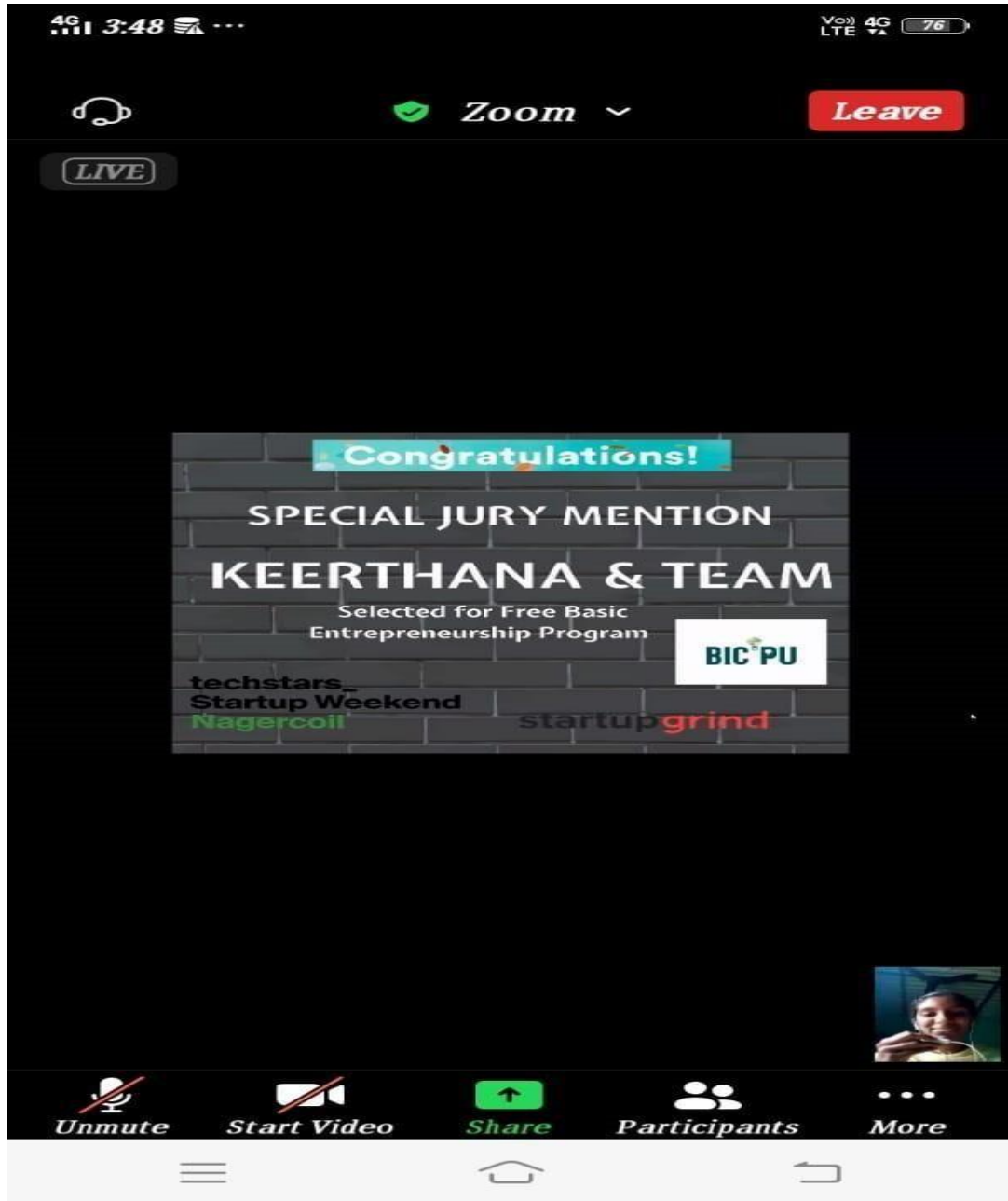

- III BSc 33 students went to Internship training on Apiculture at Tamil Nadu Agricultural University, Coimbatore.
- The training provides the opportunity for students to encounter and explore novel things in an authentic setting.
- Dr.D.Saravanan, Assistant Professor in Department of Agricultural Entomology, TNAU gave a lecture about the history, life cycle, evolutionary significance in different varieties of honeybees.
- He created knowledge in the beekeeping, by giving the useful entrepreneurial activities involved in apiculture.
- Practical explanations were given to the students by the department staffs of TNAU like, how to handle the honey bees boxes, what are the pest and predators for honeybees and flower varieties from which honeybees collect the nectar.
- He explained about the queen, worker and drones in the bee hives and roles of the bees in the hive.
- Students gained more knowledge in this field and Dr.D.Saravanan, encouraged the students to practice apiculture to become an beekeeping entrepreneur.

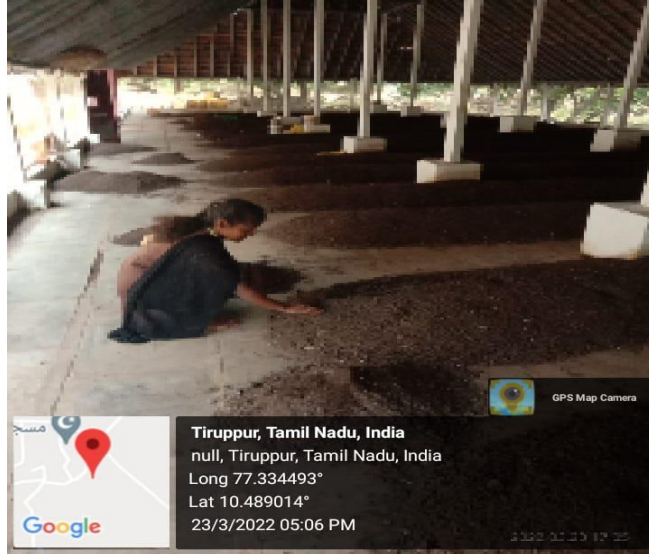

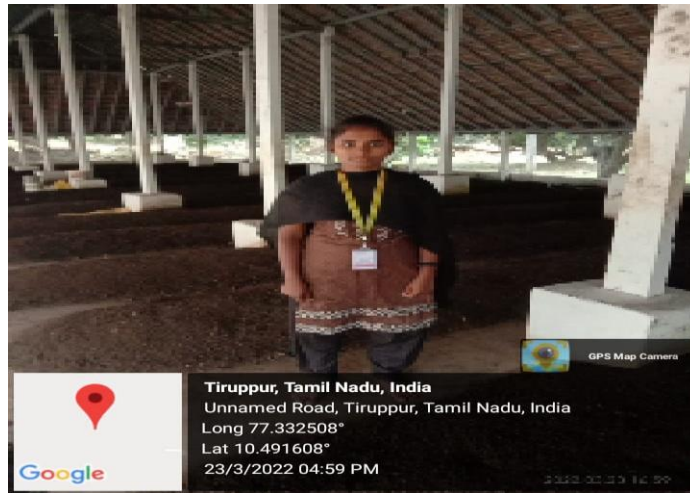
