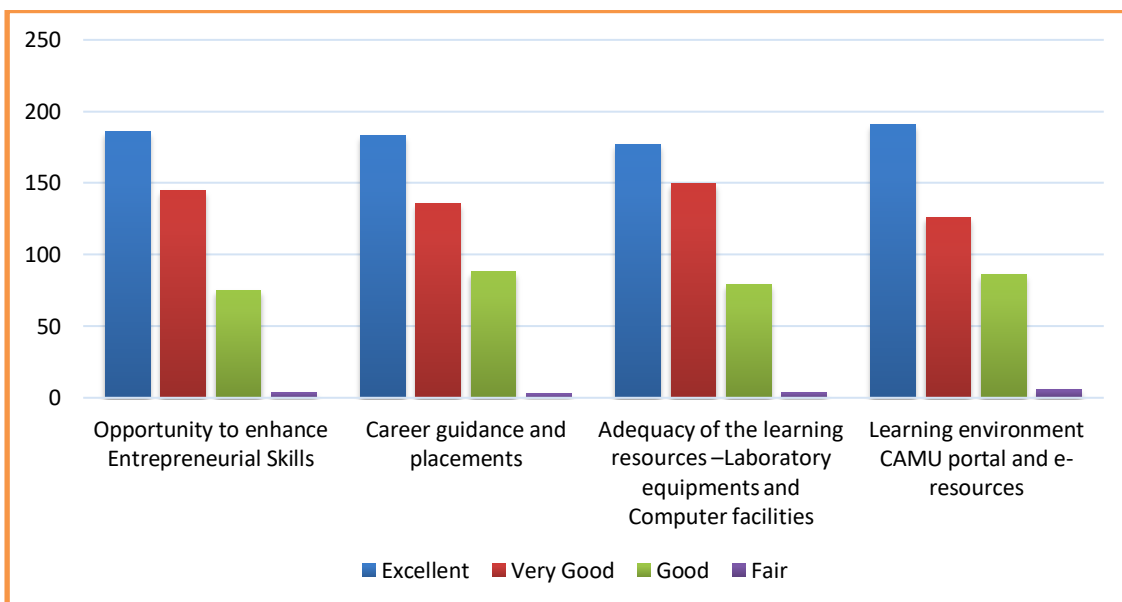
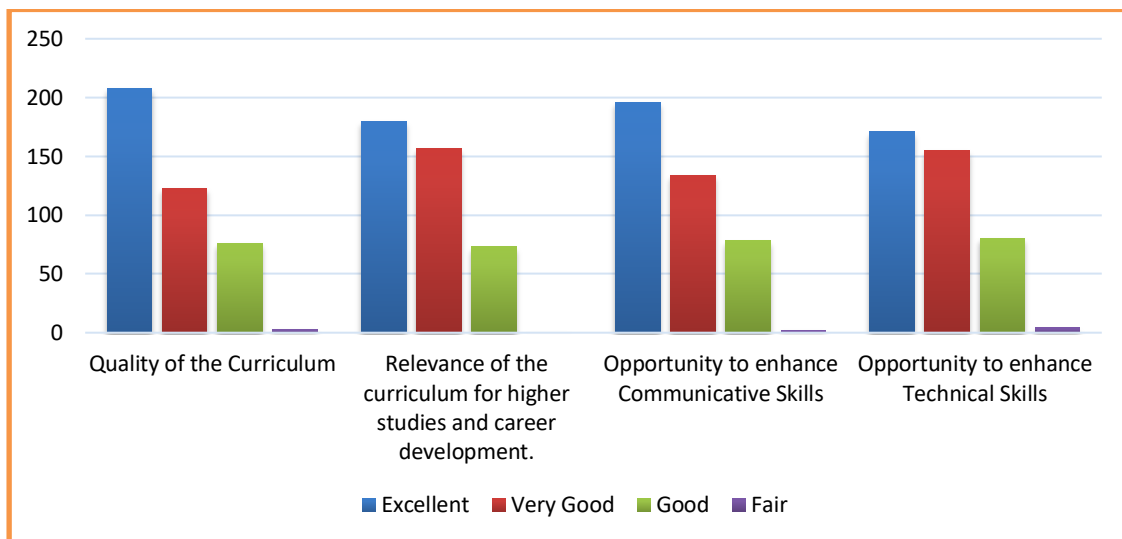

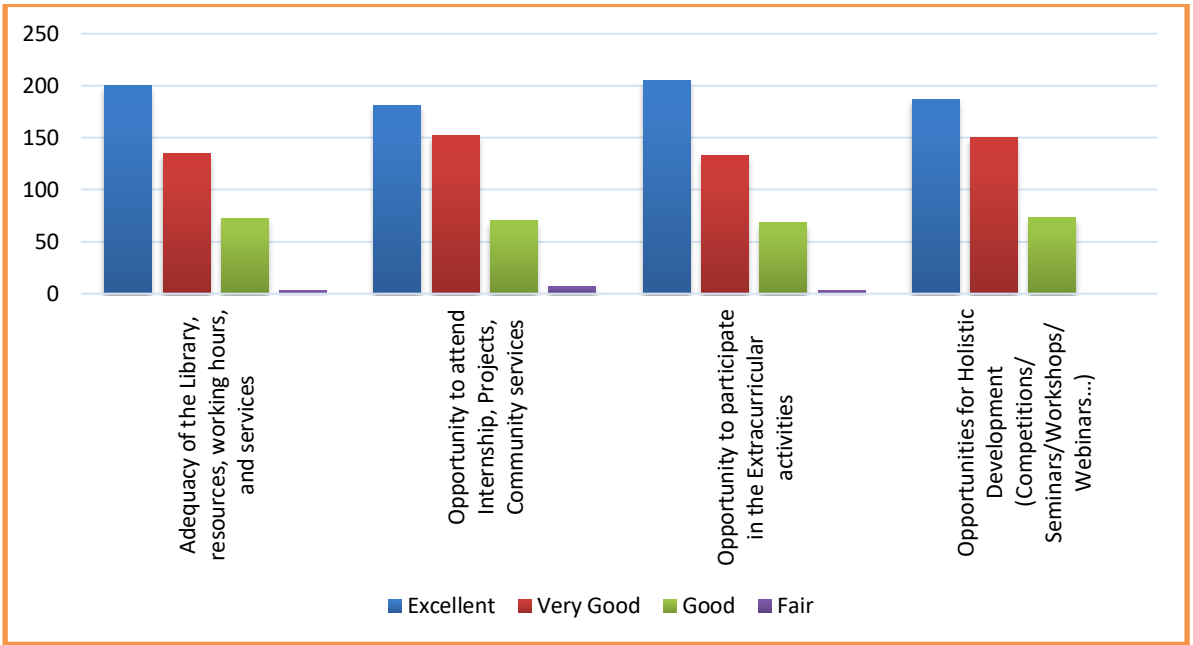
Student Selection Criterion: Every individual student is eligible to give their opinions and suggestions
