


Pongal Celebrations





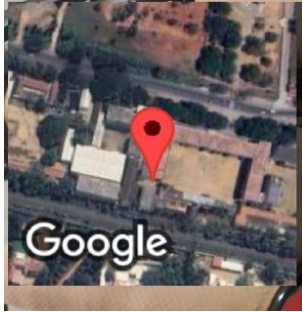
