# Feedback Analysis Report – 2018-2019




#### **Introduction:**




The survey explored five main areas including Curriculum, Teaching Learning, Infrastructure, Skills and Support systems. This report summarizes the findings in these areas.


#### Curriculum:

Students felt that Content / Strength of the syllabus is excellent and supple which is 45.4% completely relevant and 27.5 % mostly relevant to Higher studies and carrier development. They are Highly Satisfied with project, Internships and community services. 69% of Students perceives that opportunities for holistic development was Excellent.











### Placement Cell:






### Skills:

Entrepreneurial Skills: Overall, the results suggest that students perceived their achievement of learning outcomes related to entrepreneurship is high. Forty-three percent (43%) reported significant improvement in their ability to prepare effective business plans. 26% of students believed that their skills related to organization or management significantly improved.









## Infrastructure:

Students felt that Campus Facilities, Laboratory equipments and computer laboratories that are provided by institution is more sufficient.


Most of the students opines that the library has provided adequate resources.








### Teaching Learning:


More than Half of the Students (72%) observed that LMS system provides innovation in learning activity and they enjoy using it for academic purposes.

















#### Conclusion:
