MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

AND

S.V.Mills College, Rudhraveni Muthuswamy Polytechnic Palappampatti, Udumalpet, Tirupur, Tamil Nadu 642128 and represented herein by (hereinafter referred to as "Second Party", Mr.V.Nattudurai, M.E., Principal, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors in-office, administrators and assigns). First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party') as

WHEREAS:

- A) First Party is a subsidiary of Higher Educational Institution named: Entrepreneurship and skill Development Cell, Sri G.V.G Visalakshi College for Women (Autonomous), Udumalpet.
- B) First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
- C) The Parties intend to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within the area of Skill Based Training & Education.
- D) Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MoU for advancing their mutual interests.
- E) Rudraveni Muthuswamy Polytechnic College, S.V.Mills Post, Palappampatti, Udumalpet, Tirupur, Tamil Nadu 642128, the Second Party is engaged in Entrepreneurship Development, Skill Development & Education Services in Robotics and related fields.

Now therefore, in consideration of the mutual promises set forth in this MoU, the parties here to agree as follows:'

Clause 1 - Cooperation

- 1.1. Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institutions and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
- 1.2. First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the resources of both the organisations providing significant inputs in developing suitable teaching / training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the industry, the First Party.
- 1.3. The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MoU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents will be effective for 3 years between the Parties from 30.11.2021. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MoU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.

Clause 2 Scope of the MoU

- 2.1. The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological upgradation, innovation and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.
- 2.2. Curriculum Design: Second Party will give valuable inputs to the First Party in teaching, training and curriculum design to reduce the gap between industry and academics.
- 2.3. Industrial Training & Visits: Industry and Institution interaction will give an insight into practical exposure, latest developments / requirements of the industries; the Second Party to permit the Faculty and Students of the First Party to visit its premises and also involve in Industrial Training Programs for the First Party. The industrial training and exposure provided to students and faculty through this association will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academics to industry. The Second Party will provide its Labs / Workshops / Industrial Sites for the hands-on training of the learners enrolled with the First Party.
- 2.4. Entrepreneurship Development: Both Parties have agreed to carry out the joint Entrepreneurship Development activities in the fields of Robotics and related fields.
- 2.5. **Skill Development Programs:** Second Party to train the students of First Party on Robotics in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.
- 2.6. **Guest Lectures:** Second Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lectures to the students of the First Party on the technology trends and in house requirements.
- 2.7. The Second Party shall train the students in Robotics for not less than 30 hours, for a batch of 20-25 students.

Clause 3 Validity

3.1. Any act on the part of **both** the **First Party** and **Second Party** after termination of this Agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc., shall not be construed as an extension of this MoU.

Clause 4 Relationship between the Parties

4.1. It is expressly agreed that **First Party** and Second **Party** are acting under this MoU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MoU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied,
